

1. About the Organizer

a. IDegree by Woosong University

- **Endicott College of International Studies**
- **JW Kim College of Future Studies**

With a strong emphasis on **global collaboration, experiential learning, and innovation**, Woosong University, through IDegree, continues to expand its international presence and commitment to empowering learners worldwide.

b. Greecture

Greecture Series is one of IDegree's flagship developments, co-created in collaboration with EBS (Korea Educational Broadcasting System).

Greecture presents curated lectures from 135 world-renowned scholars, including 14 Nobel Prize laureates, providing students with unprecedented access to global thought leaders, innovators, and transformative ideas across diverse fields.

More than just a content platform, Greecture encourages learners to engage critically, reflect deeply, and connect global ideas to their personal perspectives, experiences, and aspirations, shifting learning from passive consumption to meaningful intellectual exploration.

2. Background

IDegree by Woosong University is a global online education initiative committed to expanding access to **high-quality, future-oriented international learning** for students around the world. Developed by Woosong University, one of South Korea's leading institutions recognized for its strong integration of academic excellence and real-world application, IDegree empowers learners to develop a **global mindset**, critical thinking abilities, and meaningful engagement with contemporary global issues.

As part of this mission, IDegree introduced the **Grecture Series**, co-developed with the Korea Educational Broadcasting System (**EBS**). Featuring lectures from **135 world-renowned scholars**, including **14 Nobel Prize laureates**, Grecture offers students unprecedented access to global thought leaders, visionary ideas, and transformative perspectives.

In response to the growing importance of reflective thinking, personal storytelling, and creative digital expression in today's world, IDegree proudly presents the **Grecture Global Shorts Competition**. This competition invites students to not only learn from the world's most influential thinkers, but to **transform that learning into personal meaning**, turning knowledge into insight, and insight into powerful personal narratives.

3. Vision and Mission

a. Vision

To empower young people to become reflective global thinkers who can articulate ideas with insight, creativity, and purpose.

b. Mission

- To encourage critical thinking through engagement with global ideas
- To foster personal reflection and independent interpretation
- To develop storytelling skills through video-based expression
- To promote awareness of global issues and diverse perspectives

4. Competition Theme

To guide participants in shaping their creative direction, the competition adopts the following theme, which highlights the essence of learning, reflection, and personal storytelling inspired by Grecture's educational content:

'Watch the World's Greatest Minds. Tell Your Own Story'

5. Goals

Participants are expected to watch selected Grecture video lectures and create a video essay that reflects their personal interpretation, insights, or experiences inspired by the ideas presented.

This competition does not seek summaries or reviews of the lectures, but rather original and meaningful reflections that connect broader concepts with individual perspectives, values, or real-life experiences.

6. Eligibility

The competition is open to students from **any nationality and country around the world**. Participants may join under one of the following tracks:

- a. **High School Track:** Students who are currently enrolled in high school (or an equivalent level of education).
- b. **University Track:** Students who are currently enrolled in a university or higher education institution.

Participation in this competition is **individual only**. Team or group submissions are **not permitted**. Participants must ensure they submit under the **correct category** according to their current student status.

7. Submission Requirements

To ensure fairness, clarity, and consistency throughout the competition, participants are required to follow the submission guidelines outlined below. These requirements define the expected format and criteria for all entries:

- a. One (1) original video essay
- b. Maximum duration: 5 minutes
- c. Video must be created and narrated by the participant
- d. Completion of the online application form
- e. Agreement to the participation **terms and conditions**; Free subscription valid for one month only, you have to unsubscribe before trial ends. If not, that means you agree to continue the monthly-paid subscription.

8. Video Content Guidelines

To ensure fairness, originality, and clarity of expectations, participants must comply with the following guidelines:

a. Video Format Flexibility:

Participants may submit videos in either **landscape or portrait** format.

b. Originality and Personal Interpretation:

Videos must be entirely **original** and based on the participant's own thoughts, reflections, and interpretations.

c. What Do We Mean by “Video Essay” in This Competition?

In this competition, a **video essay** refers to a **creative, reflective, and personal storytelling video** expressing how the participant's thoughts, perspectives, or experiences were influenced by watching Grecture content.

Participants are encouraged to:

- Reflect on what they learned
- Relate it to personal experiences, values, or aspirations
- Share meaningful insights rather than explaining the lecture
- Communicate authentically in any creative style
- Participants may additionally upload the video to YouTube or Instagram and include the link in the submission form. If the video is not uploaded to any social media platform, please write “None.”
- The supplementary slides may include reflection or summary of what participants acquire based on Grecture series. This is optional. If no supplementary slides are uploaded, please write “—”.

This competition does **not** seek lecture explanations, academic summaries, or simple reviews. It seeks **personal expression and intellectual reflection**.

d. Editing and Creative Expression:

There is **no limitation on editing style**. Participants are free to design their video creatively. However, the use of **original lecture footage, screenshots, photographs of scholars, or any copyrighted materials from Grecture** is strictly prohibited.

e. Focus of Content:

Participants should prioritize **personal reflection, storytelling, and critical**

insight, rather than descriptive summaries of Grecture lectures.

f. Copyright Compliance:

Participants must strictly adhere to copyright and licensing regulations. The use of **original Grecture lecture videos**, recorded content clips, screenshots, images of scholars, or any copyrighted third-party materials is **strictly prohibited** in the submitted video.

However, participants are allowed to show **non-copyright sensitive elements**, such as the **platform interface**, general website views, or course selection pages, as long as no protected lecture footage or scholar imagery is displayed.

Any violation of copyright rules may result in **disqualification**.

g. File Size:

The maximum allowed file size for uploads is 1GB. Any supplementary slides, along with the video, must be submitted in ZIP format.

9. How to Apply

To participate in the competition, please follow the steps below:

1. **Visit the official competition website.**
2. **Subscribe to the Grecture platform** (one-month free access will be provided).
3. **Watch the Grecture video series** and explore the learning content.
4. **Record your video essay**, reflecting your personal insights and experience.
5. **Submit the online application form along with your video** through the official submission platform.

Detailed instructions, including upload format and submission link, will be available on the competition website.

10. Competition Timeline

To help participants plan their preparation and submission, please take note of the following schedule:

- **Submission Period:** 1 February – 28 February 2026
- **Results Announcement:** 31 March 2026

Late submissions will **not** be accepted under any circumstances.

11. Judging Criteria

Entries will be evaluated carefully by the judging panel based on the following criteria:

- Depth of insight and understanding
- Originality and personal perspective
- Storytelling quality and structure
- Relevance to broader issues, ideas, or themes
- Overall creativity and clarity of message

The judging process follows a standardized scoring system to ensure fairness and consistency.

12. Prizes and Awards

To acknowledge outstanding work, the following awards will be granted:

Total Prize Pool: USD 3,400

a. University Category

- **Grand Prize (1 winner):** USD 500 + EBS Certificate
- **Excellence Prize (3 winners):** USD 200 + EBS Certificate
- **Merit Prize (6 winners):** USD 100 + IDegree Certificate

b. High School Category

- **Grand Prize (1 winner):** USD 500 + EBS Certificate
- **Excellence Prize (3 winners):** USD 200 + EBS Certificate
- **Merit Prize (6 winners):** USD 100 + IDegree Certificate

Awardees may also receive additional recognition opportunities as determined by the organizer.

- Entries containing **copyrighted or unauthorized materials** will not be evaluated.
- The decision of the judges is **final and irrevocable**.
- Submitted works may be used by the organizer for **promotional and educational purposes** with proper credit to the creator.

Subscription Policy Notice

- Participants are eligible for a **one-month free subscription** to access the Grecture video series.
- After the free trial period ends, the subscription will be **automatically converted into a paid subscription** in accordance with the platform's policy. Participants who do not wish to continue the subscription are **fully responsible** for canceling before the free trial period ends. Failure to do so will result in automatic charges.

The organizer is **not responsible** for any charges incurred due to late cancellation
